Dear Sir:

At a meeting of the Directors of the Canadian Olympic Association held on November 1st, 1958, the application of the City of Calgary, Alberta, to hold the Winter Olympic Games of 1964 at that city was unanimously approved. It is with great pleasure that I wish to inform you officially that the City of Calgary, Alberta intends to make a bid to stage the 1964 or 1968 Winter Olympic Games.

In accordance with the instructions issued by the International Olympic Committee the members of the Calgary, Alberta Development Association have been informed of all the requirements necessary to stage the Winter Games. I have been informed that the Calgary venture has now secured the unqualified approval of our Federal Government, the Government of the Province of Alberta and of the City of Calgary. The application from Calgary to stage these Games will be discussed at a meeting of the directors of the Canadian Olympic Association which is to take place in Toronto on 1st November 1958, but I am confident that the Calgary bid will receive the support of the Canadian Olympic Association. I will communicate with you further and furnish you with full details as to the various venues which it is proposed to make use of.
